Steps to create your FSA ID

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¿What is the FSA ID?

- An FSA ID consists of an account username and password that you create in order to gain access to the U.S. Department of Education's online systems, including StudentAid.gov.
- An FSA ID can serve as your legal signature when completing electronic documents.
- FSA ID secures your personal identification information.
- You'll need your Social Security number (SSN) (if applicable) and your own email address to create an FSA ID. FSA ID matches your information with the Social Security data base.
- Only you should have access to these credentials and cannot be shared or used with another individual.

Introduce your email address. It has to be an active address.

Create a user and password (password cannot contain information related to your name, date of birth o social security number).


